Travel Research Fellowships for Graduate Students and Postdoctoral Scholars

Description of the fellowships

In order to foster collaboration between university researchers and our partners at national and defense laboratories, MSEE is pleased to announce the availability of *Travel Research Fellowships*. These fellowships provide funds for graduate students and post-doctoral scholars to make extended visits of one month or more to work with collaborators at national (DOE/NNSA) and defense (DOD) laboratories. Fellowship funds can be used to cover travel, housing, and incidental expenses associated with these visits. The maximum award amount is \$5,000.

Who is eligible

Graduate students and postdoctoral scholars working on MSEE projects for an MSEE-funded principal investigator.

How to apply

Compile the attached application and email it to mseeura@jhu.edu.

Application deadline

Applications will be accepted on an ongoing basis but must be submitted at least four months before the planned travel allow time for review and a subaward issued to the student's institution.

Reporting requirement

Fellowship recipients will be required to submit a brief report at the end of the fellowship period describing the outcome of the visit.
